Solar Eclipse Travel Restrictions Monday, 8/21/17

Holiday Closing List for Oversize/Overweight Permits

<i>Jurisdiction</i>	<i>Date Closed</i>	<i>Restrictions</i>
Colorado	Open	Due to the increased mobility and safety concerns brought about by the upcoming Solar Eclipse, The Colorado Department of Transportation has decided to restrict all over size/ over weight travel North of Highway 50 from Kansas to Utah commencing from sundown Thursday August 17th continuing through sunrise on Wednesday August 23, 2017.
Georgia	Open	No Travel Restrictions
Idaho	Open	Starting Sunday, Aug. 20th at 4 p.m. and ending at dawn Aug. 22 loads exceeding 10' wide, 100' long or 14'6" may not travel on Interstate or State highways south of Lewiston.
Illinois	Open	No Travel Restrictions
Iowa	Open	No Travel Restrictions
Indiana	Open	No Travel Restrictions
Kansas	Open	No Travel Restrictions KDOT will NOT shut down movement of permitted loads for the eclipse event. However, KDOT wishes carriers to be aware there is a high possibility of highway congestion related to the eclipse event for the dates of August 19th, 20th, 21st, & 22nd. Possible areas affected could include routes east of the 1-35/1-135/US-81 corridor, with concentrations in the NE corner along US-75, US-36, K-4 among others. Carriers are advised to consider their routing and be aware and prepared for extra traffic.
Kentucky	Open	No Travel Restrictions
Missouri	Closed 8/21	No Super Load moves 8/19, 8/20, or 8/21
Montana	Open	No Travel Restrictions
Nebraska	Open	No Oversize loads will not be able to travel from Sundown on Friday, August 18 until Sunrise on Tuesday, August 22. Overweight only can travel.
North Carolina	Open	No Travel Restrictions
South Carolina	Open	No Travel Restrictions-Still pending.
Oregon	Open	Beginning at 12 noon on Friday, August 18, 2017, all loads over 8 feet 06 in. in width will not be allowed to travel on any state highway in Oregon. The restriction is due to the total solar eclipse on Monday, August 21, 2017. Overwidth movement may resume on Tuesday morning, August 22, 2017 – no overwidth travel is allowed on Saturday, Sunday, or Monday of that weekend. Refer to the attachments that came with your permit for the time overwidth movement may recommence on Tuesday morning.
Tennessee	Open	No Travel Restrictions
Washington	Open	No Oversize Loads on SR 14, Mileposts 28-152 and US 97, Mileposts 0.00-33.00, (in Washington), from Friday, 12:00 (noon), August 18th through Tuesday morning (sunrise), August 22, 2017.
Wyoming	Open	Wyoming State Patrol will not be issuing any oversized or overweight permits on August 20 through the 22nd to help with traffic flow during the eclipse. No travel 8/20 – 8/22 9:00pm for all over-dimensional loads even if permit in hand on any interstate or primary & secondary highways.
